

## Acts of the Ontario Provincial Executive Council

### 2022 to 2024

The Provincial Executive Council functions between sessions of the Provincial Synod to carry on its work, but without the Synod's legislative power to enact Canons or amend the Constitution. The following list is of substantive actions (not including procedural motions) taken by the Council:

- Established the Priorities for the Provincial Synod's work as Vocations and Formation.

In conformity with Canon V 2 (g) nominees presented by the dioceses were confirmed as the members of the Provincial Court of Appeal

- Adopted the 2021 financial statements
- Adopted the 2022 budget
- Adopted the 2022 financial statements
- Adopted the 2023 budget
- Adopted the 2023 financial statements
- Adopted the 2024 budget
- Appointed auditors as required for the triennium.
- Received reports from, and oversaw the work or the Province's involvement in:
  - the Commission on Theological Education,
  - the Advisory Commission on Postulants for Ordination, .
  - the ongoing work of the Executive Officers on topics of common interest
  - Planning for Synod 2024
- Granted funding to the Bishop Thomas Corston School of Ministry in Moosonee
- Installation of Alex Pierson as the Executive Officer of the Ecclesiastical Province of Ontario.
- Established the Mandate and Terms of Reference for the Provincial Policy on Misconduct Task Force
